**S**ince a hot spring was discovered in Unzen over 1,000 years ago, it has prospered as a hot spring resort. In 1934 it was designated as Japan's first National Park, and has been admired as a summer retreat for foreigners. Built in 1935, this hotel is built like a mountain cottage in a Swiss-chalet style with art deco interiors, and spaces such as the Billiard Room that maintain the elegance of the time it was constructed. In the Dining Hall, which once held dance parties, enjoy French cuisine prepared with ingredients that only Unzen can provide.
